The Lodge:

The Lodge is beside the Victoria River, near key gathering sites and migration routers for all types of big game and has attracted the attracted the interest of hunters and fisherman alike.

The Lodge is located on one of the best areas for Black Bear and other big game hunting anywhere in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador – and perhaps even in North America.

Our site consists of a Main Lodge and Four Modern Cabins with Telephone Services Provided. The Lodge contains a very spacious and cheerful Dining and Lounge area overlooking Victoria River, a full kitchen, & two fully equipped bathrooms (one fully wheel chair accessible bathroom). The adjacent Three Cabins are designed to accommodate up to three people each, and the Fourth Cabin is for Families with a room divider for privacy and can accommodate up to four people or a Small Family.





Air Travel:

Newfoundland is the most easterly point in North America and is the closest to Europe. If flying to Newfoundland you would fly with Air Canada from Frankfurt or Munich to Toronto and Toronto into Gander International Airport. Upon your arrival in Gander we will meet you at the airport if possible on Saturday evening otherwise it's a short taxi ride to the Hotel.

The next day you will leave Gander (Sunday) and drive 4 hours to Victoria Lodge (2 hours on black-top pavement and 2 hours on gravel road). After your 6 day hunt you will then retours to Gander the following Sunday for departure on an evening flight or early Monday morning.



# Black Bear Hunting:

Black Bears are Native to Newfoundland and are among the Largest Black Bears in North America with spring weights exceeding 500 lbs.; one of the largest weighed in at 676 lbs. and would put this bear close to 800 lbs. in the fall.

Our partner is located in prime areas for some of the largest Black Bears in North America (potential trophy size). The average weight of the Black Bears are from 250 lbs. to 350 lbs. with always the chance of taking one over 500 lbs. Skull size to date have ranged from 16 inch to over 21 inch with the largest length being 78 inch from nose to tail

### Moose Hunting:

Moose are not native to Newfoundland but were introduced to Newfoundland and from there have grown tremendously since 1904.

The Bull Moose rut or breeding season begins towards late September and continues until mid October.

The Moose shed their Antlers during the winter and they begin to grow again in Early Spring until Late August when they have reached the full potential.

The Lodge is located about 40 miles South of Millertown in Central Newfoundland. This area is one of the largest Moose Populations per square mile and one of the highest repopulation rates than most other areas.
