



Hunt in Sweden The hunting areas of our partner, Camp Lapponia, are in the South part of Lapland. There are 4 hunting areas and have 8,000 ha, 4,600 ha, 3,100 ha and 2,400 ha respectively.





Airport: The nearest international Airport to the camp is Vilhelmina/Lycksele. Alternatively Umea

airport is also an option.

Method of Black Grouse males are exclusively hunted on courtship territory, Hazel Grouse males are hunting: hunted with decoys and Capercaillie males are typically hunted for in the North Swedish

region with the Finn Spitz.


Weapons Bird hunting:

22 Hornet or higher with full metal jacket. A shotgun over and under or a drilling is a very

good choice.



2 pairs of hard-wearing long trousers

warm socks warm underwear warm sweaters

comfortable shirts or T-shirts

personal medication, own small first aid kit

Flashlight and extra batteries

Photographic equipment, and film equipment with sufficient film (or digital camera) and batteries, etc.

lightweight binoculars (8x30 or 10x40) for wildlife watching

Backpack (light and quiet for the daily stalking)

lightweight cushion

Shooting stick (dismantled), if you are used to it

Duffle bags are better for transportation than a suitcase

Hunting rifle with telescopic sight and matching gun case

Passport, European firearms pass (EFP) Hunting and weapons license, driver's license, credit card, traveler's checks, airline tickets, etc.
