



Hunting in Utah / USA

Great hunt in the stunning landscape of the Rockies! This hunt can also be combined with Black Bear; the focus should however be on Mountain Lions! In Utah the strongest Mountain Lions are harvested each year!





Journey:

Journey via Frankfurt – Salt Lake City- Utah City. You will be picked up by our partner Wade Lemon Hunting and brought to a hotel in the city.


Travel time depending on hunting ground and location between 2.5 and 5 hours from the airport to the hotel! Hunting grounds are located about 30 minutes away from the hotel!

- Hotel price per guest/ day USD 75 80 -
- Renting a rifle is recommended.
 Calibers from .243 Win.Mag. to .30.06 are available!
- 2 Clients at the same time are not a problem.

Hunting season:

November - April





Hunting Mountain Lion/ Puma

Puma hunting is tough and you might be on the hunt the whole day.

Often no break can be taken – you hunt all day long! When the hounds found a track, you have to keep to it.

Up to 4 guides accompany a guest with snowmobiles, horses, 4Wheeler, GPRS, ATVs, etc.!

• The hunt starts at 5 a.m. After a short stop at a cafeteria and shopping food for the day, you move on to the hunting area. The whole team immediately starts searching for Puma tracks. As soon as these are found - and there are plenty of those – the hounds are released and the hunt begins!

Without exception only mature Mountain Lions are harvested!



• The evening after the hunt you return to the hotel. Here you have all amenities: Shower, dinner in the restaurant, and a good rest.

After the shooting, the Puma is skinned on site and sent to Phil Soucy Taxydermystudios www.thecatman@frontiernet.net, Utah is a rugged, harsh area; Phil is the best around.

The hounds and guides of our partner are the best in the country; they work hard to ensure that their guests return home with trophies! Sometimes the Mountain Lion backs out into inaccessible territory and it is impossible to follow! In this case, the hunt has to be terminated, the guests need to understand and accept this. The hunt is only successful, if there is harmony between nature, humans and animals.

Our partner puts a lot of effort into conducting this hunt - more than into other hunts.

The ultimate aim is success: The Mountain Lion

Should the hunt end early, there are the following options:

- Driving by rental car to Las Vegas and/or to the adjacent national parks
- 1 or 2 days of hunting Pheasants from a gorgeous hunting lodge
- Rebooking / advancement of return flight

- *100% tax deductible Conservation Tag
- *Landowner tags (Reservation)

Bobcat/Lynx

We can also hunt Bobcat/Lynx cat from the end of November to the first week in February. This hunt can be combined with lion or can be hunted separately.

Tags for Bobcat/Lynx cat are restricted and must be obtained along with your license prior to October 1st.
