Our partner works hard to find only the best trophies for our clients, with most bears in the 8'6" to 9'6" range.

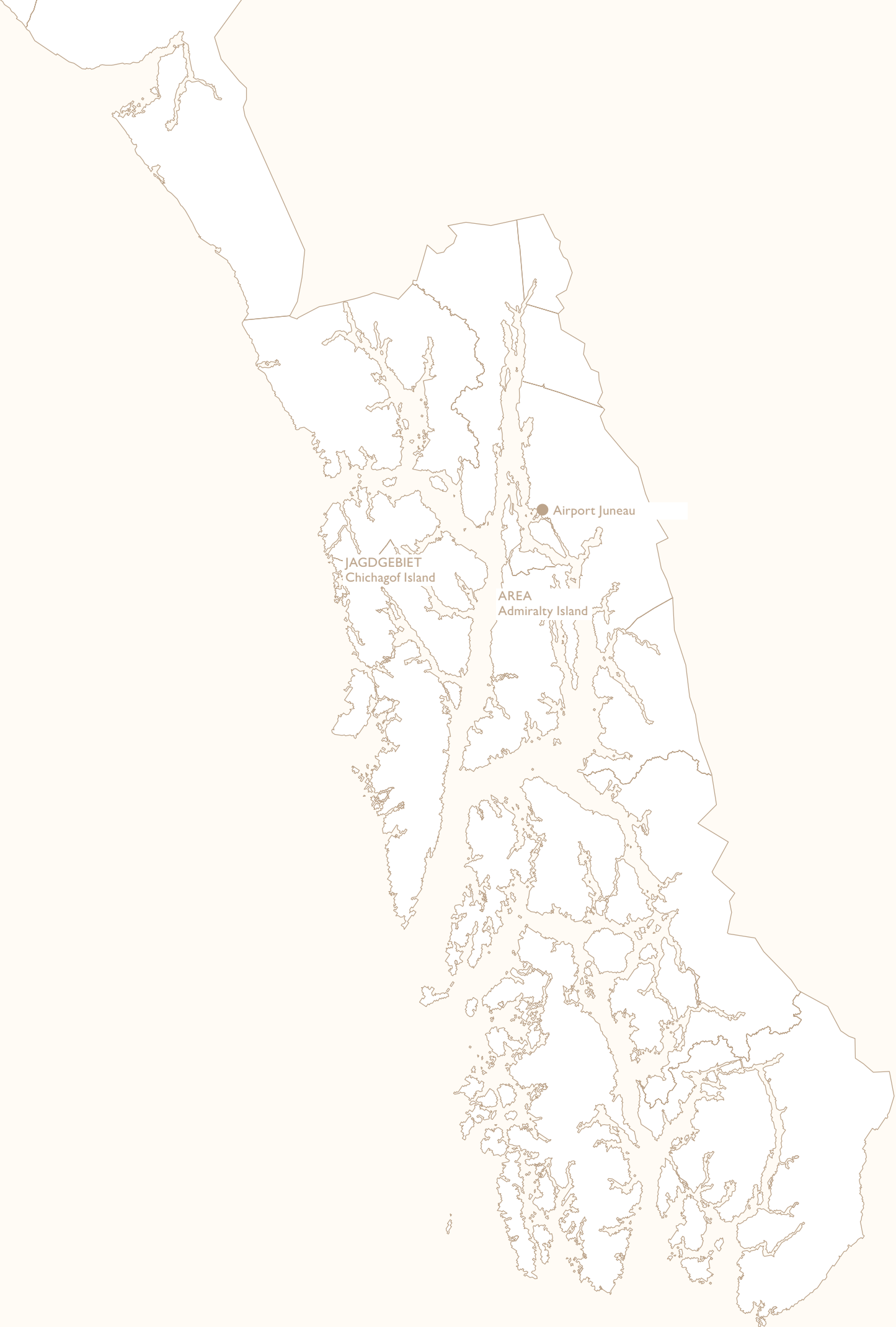
Not only does he work to give you the opportunity to bag a brown bear, he sells all of his hunts as an adventure. You are immersed in the natural beauty and awe of a

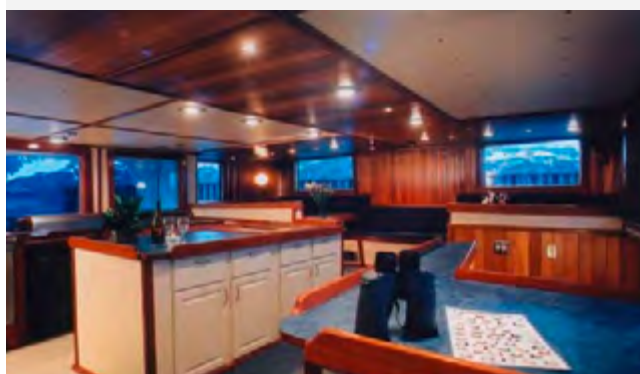

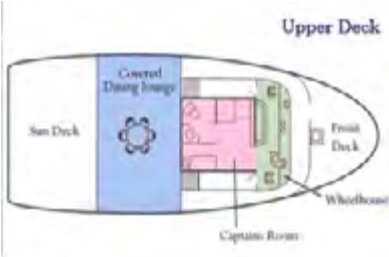
ACCOMMODATION

PLEASE NOTE: Prices for licenses, taxes and fuel can change and increase at short notice. Please understand that we cannot influence these things and that you may have to accept any price increases.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

The hunt takes place in Tongass National Park, the largest national park in the United States and also the wettest.

Having the right equipment is crucial to making your trip as enjoyable as possible. Some of the equipment can be brought with you, or you can buy most of what you need in Alaska. The "onion system" is very important as you will spend a lot of time sitting in skiffs (boats) and on shorelines. Expect temperatures from 2 to 15 °C.

Our partner usually wears long polypro underwear, light fleece pants, fleece sweaters or a fleece jacket depending on the temperature, "Simms G4 Guide Waders" and a raincoat. During the day you don't choose the waders (rarely), you wear wool socks and insulated "XTRATUF brand rubber boots". It keeps you warm while you are on the boat and when you are stalking.

Our partner recommends warm layers of comfortable clothing; also recommended are wool, fleece, baseball cap, hat, warm waterproof gloves and comfortable shoes for relaxing on board.

PLEASE BRING:

Rain protection

* Rain protection / gore-tex

Can be ordered from Cabelas or purchased in Alaska.

* Waders- our partner has recently started wearing waders instead of rain pants and rubber boots. The new Simms are amazing, keep you dry when stalking as well as getting in and out of the skiff. Go to www.simmsfishing.com. They carry the G4Z waders, or the Gore-Tex breathable waders, with high waist or up to the chest are more than adequate. Look "Headwater Boot" about waders, but not felt, Alaska has banned the use of felt soles.

Please let us know if you have any questions about waders, no neoprene or chunky waders!

Note - you don't have to buy the G4Z, these are very expensive but really good. If you are looking for an alternative option please look at Headwater Series.

Hunting equipment you need:

Good binoculars with lens

Camera, digitals are great and there is 110v for charging batteries

Headlamp

Waterproof Daypack

Ball Cap and Stocking Cap

Warm waterproof gloves

Comfortable shoes for relaxing on boat

Personal Toiletries, including sunscreen and sunglasses (when it is sunny it is easy to get burned being on the water all day).

Scoped rifle, two boxes of shells 180 grain or better, scope covers and dry rag or chamois for cleaning scope. Average shot is 150 yards or less, but maybe out to 200 yards..



ALASKA LAW DICTATES THAT A WOUNDED BEAR IS A TAGGED BEAR: BE SURE OF YOUR RIFLE AND THAT YOU ARE COMFORTABLE SHOOTING TO 200 YARDS.

Spirits are not available on board - if necessary, please buy them on board and bring them with you.

Rifles - we will have a variety of firearms aboard the vessel available for rent, USD 25,— per day. The fee includes ammunition.

Gifts / Accessories- we also have a variety of other merchandise available aboard the vessel including hats, shirts, raincoats and fleeces.

Our partner accept most major credit card, checks or cash aboard the vessel.

Please bring:

Warm layers of comfortable clothing, wool and fleece recommended. Take a look at the Downpour collection. They usually wear MT050 Cabelas or similar hunting pants.

Baseball cap, beanie or similar, neoprene or fleece is good. Ski goggles are good if you have skiff rides..

Warm waterproof gloves and / or leather gloves. You use Gore-Tex hunting gloves while riding and lighter gloves for hiking. Leather or similar is good as there are prickly bushes in the bush that you move through.

Comfortable shoes for relaxing on board.

Xtra-tuff brand rubber boots are best purchased in Juneau. They start at USD 90. Of all, this is the most recommended. There are no other boots that have the traction needed on the boats and beaches.

Leather boots- are optional, but some hunters prefer them. If you are stalking these will usually get wet



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
