## HUNTING IN ARGENTINA

From the plains of Buenos Aires province to the mountains of Patagonia, crossing the scrublands of La Pampa province, our country offers a great variety of native and exotic species. Argentina is one of the most recognized hunting and fishing destinations around the world.

In Argentina, it is possible to hunt the following game. Red Deer, Buffalo, Fallow Deer, Blackbuck, Multi-Horned Sheep, Axis Deer, Peccary, Mouflon, Feral Goat, Puma, Wild Boar, Feral Sheep and Small Game.

Gun importation permit and hunting license value are subject to change according the Argentinean authorities policies.

The seasons are throughout the whole year except red stag and fallow deer. Their season goes from March to August.

## CLIMATE

There is a six-month difference in seasons compared to Europe: Their winter happens during European summer and vice versa. Given the size of the country, Argentina covers several climate zones.

This translates to a subtropical climate in the north (extremely hot and humid summers), an arctic climate in the south, and a more temperate climate in the capital and the more economically significant provinces. There can be abrupt and significant temperature changes throughout the country.

### Advice

In the tropical and subtropical zone, major stresses on the body should be avoided, especially while acclimating. Make sure you are drinking enough fluids, especially during the hot season. You should eat light meals and avoid fatty foods; excessive alcohol consumption will further reduce the body's resilience, which is already impaired.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

## HEALTH

The poor hygiene in public hospitals means that they do not meet European standards. The situation in private hospitals is better. The supply of medicines is OK.

### Vaccinations

Please note the vaccination requirements for each country. This information is provided by the relevant institute of tropical medicine. If vaccinations are required, please note that you are personally responsible for complying with the rules.

### Caution

Make sure you follow standard hygiene measures, such as washing your hands frequently. Caution is advised when eating raw fruit and salads. Do not drink tap water (it contains chlorine and is often contaminated). Taking a first-aid kit containing your regular medication plus medication for common travel-related illnesses is recommended."



## INSURANCE

Taking out travel insurance in case you fall ill or require ambulance services is strongly advised.

# PROVINCE LA PAMPA



located in the province of La Pampa; the heart of the big game hunting area and 450 miles from Buenos Aires.





# ACCOMMODATION



## ESTANCIA LA MOTA

The best way to get this great hunting area is by air through Santa Rosa airport located at 70 miles from the ranch. La Mota Lodge resides in a 57,000 acres ranch located along the salt lakes and calden forests of Utracan department in one of the wildest regions of Argentina.

Hunters will be able to find the best quality available in the country for more of fifteen big game hunting species including red stag, axis deer, fallow deer, wild boar, blackbuck, water buffalo, multi horn ram and mouflon, among other game species.

It features nine double bedrooms with private bathroom in 10,000 square foot construction located next to Provincial Route 13. The lodge provides Wifi Internet; satellite TV, cell phone service, SPA, Gym, and all the comfort required by the international standards. Meals are prepared by professional chefs based in finest Argentinean beef and game meat. Quality wine from the cellar of the ranch is another highlight of the place.



## ESTANCIA EL CARRIZAL

The best way to get this ranch from Buenos Aires is by plane through Bahia Blanca airport, which receives many daily flights from BA. The distance between this airport and the ranch is about of 100 miles.

Estancia El Carrizal is located in the province of La Pampa, very close to Bernasconi town. El Carrizal lodge resides in a 10,000 acres ranch located along the salt lakes and calden tree forests of Hucal department in one of the wildest regions of Argentina. It facilities include eleven double bedrooms with private bathroom in 5,000 square foot construction located next to National Route 35.

The lodge provides Wifi Internet, satellite TV, cell phone service and all the comfort required by the international standards. Meals are prepared by professional chefs based in finest Argentinean beef and game meat. Quality wine from the cellar of the ranch is another highlight of the place.

# PATAGONIA MOUNTAINS



Is located in the province of Neuquén; the heart of the Patagonia Mountains. It is one of the best big game mountains hunting area of Argentina and lies 1000 miles southwest from Buenos Aires. After having arrived by plane via Buenos Aires in San Carlos de Bariloche Airport, you are picked up at the airport and transfer by car to the lodge (travel time approx. 1 h).



# ACCOMMODATION



## ALICURA LODGE BY ALGAR

Our 60,000 acre (24,000 hectares) private ranch is located just 60 miles north of the beautiful city of San Carlos de Bariloche.

Accommodation is of the highest quality; the lodge was recently renovated, it has six master bedrooms. There is a chef who excels in the preparation of de-

licious local and International cuisine. Argentine wine and beer are freely available during meals. Services include Premium accommodation, Valet laundry, Wifi access and sightseeing or shopping tours for non-hunting guests.





## CALCATRE LODGE BY ALGAR

## RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT



It depends on the region and the season chosen by the hunter. Since Argentina doesn't have as extreme weather conditions as North America or Europe we recommend you bring clothing for mild/cold weather. During our fall, we recommend light but strong shirts and trousers, wool sweater, hat and a heavy jacket just in case. Camo gear is allowed in Argentina.

For still hunts during the night (allowed in Argentina for several game as puma, wild boar and so on) heavier clothes are required because the nights can be cold. Special underwear, gloves and a warm hat are useful.

As for the footwear, we recommend comfortable waterproof boots, suitable for long walks.

Do not forget your personal hygiene stuff.

Regarding the hunting equipment, the hunter is free to bring whatever considers useful for this hunt: binoculars, pocketknife, photo camera, flashlight and so on.
