ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Please note the entry requirements for the respective country. Information can be obtained at the responsible consulate. In case a visa is needed, please be advised, that the acquisition is your own responsibility.

ENTRY FORMALITIES:

Passport or Identity Card, valid hunting license, valid EU-Firearm pass



CLIMATE

Central European climate with warm summers and cold winters. Snowfall possible from October.



HEALTH

Vaccination requirements

No vaccinations are required for entry into Austria.

Vaccinations against tetanus, diphtheria, and whooping cough (pertussis) are recommended. Boosters are recommended every 10 years. Adults should also be able to demonstrate proof that they are vaccinated against mumps, measles, and rubella. In large parts of the country, ticks transmit the tickborne encephalitis virus (TBEV).

In Austria, being vaccinated against TBEV is officially recommended. Please consult your doctor or a doctor specializing in travel medicine for advice on this vaccination.

FORSTHAUS IN STEIN

MINIMUM STAY: 2 nights

DESCRIPTION: The lodge stands alone at the end of a forest road between the 1,000-year-old Stein Castle and the village of Stein. A magnificent view, absolute tranquillity and the location at the edge of the forest make the location truly unique. The newly renovated forester's lodge is located in the heart of the "Drautal" and is perfect for families and groups who are looking for peace and quiet and a range of opportunities for excursions, in addition to hunting. The next larger village is "Dellach im Drautal", which approx. 20-25 minutes away by car.

HUNTING AREA:

The area is about 3.500 ha and is located near Dellach, Drautal in Upper Carinthia.

GAME SPECIES / HUNTING SEASONS:

Chamois	01.08.–31.12.
Red stag	01.08.–31.12.
Red stag	01.06.–30.10.
Marmot	01.08.–15.10.

The predominant game species in this area are chamois and red deer. Both the chamois and deer hunts are strenuous and demand technical skill from the shooter. However, with a good basic condition of the hunter it will be remembered by everyone as a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

HUNTING TYPES:

With chamois and stag hunt occasionally strenuous stalking. On all other game species also stalking and/or hide.

TROPHY RATING:

Antlers are weighed 24 hours after boiling out with a large brain dish

TEST SHOOTING:

In order to guarantee a fair and successful hunt, a control shot should be taken with the hunting guide before the hunt.

No guarantee can be given for the shooting of a certain, desired class or quality. The stalking guides or stand escorts are to be followed in all cases. They will do their best to make your hunting days carefree and successful and will give you their best. Please trust in their experience and guidance.

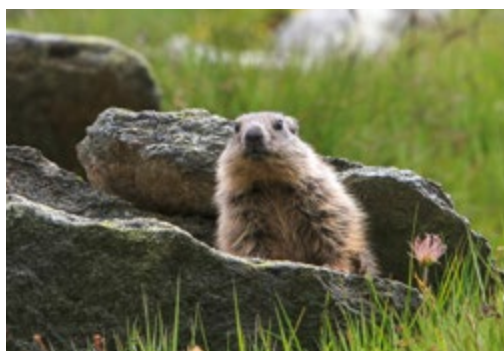
