CLIMATE

There are no seasons as such, just a shift from the rainy to the dry season. In the south, it is hot and humid all year round (only cooler in places because of altitude) with a rainy season from June to October. In the north, there is a very hot dry season from February to May.

Advice:

Significant stress on the body should be avoided, especially while acclimating. Make sure you are drinking enough fluids, especially during the hot season. You should eat light meals and avoid fatty foods; excessive alcohol consumption will further reduce the body's resilience, which is already impaired. The most pleasant time to travel is October to May. Light European summer clothing is recommended.



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Please note the entry requirements for the respective country. Information can be obtained at the responsible consulate. In case a visa is needed, please be advised, that the acquisition is your own responsibility.

Importing weapons:

Cameroon allows you to import up to two rifles and one shotgun per hunter temporarily, each with a maximum of 50 cartridges per weapon.



HEALTH

There has been an outbreak of cholera in recent years. This has mainly affected Douala and the surrounding area, as well as the capital of Yaoundé. Travelers are therefore strongly advised to get a preventive vaccination.

Vaccinations:

Please check the vaccination rules for each country. This information is provided by the relevant institute of tropical medicine. If vaccinations are required, please note that you are personally responsible for complying with the rules.

On entry, a vaccination against yellow fever is mandatory. The authorities are strict about checking vaccination records! However, apart from the basic vaccinations for all travelers (diphtheria/tetanus/polio, hepatitis A, and typhoid), the travel clinic also recommends a preventive vaccination against cholera and purulent meningitis for all travelers and also against hepatitis B and rabies for individual tourists and campers. Courses of malaria treatment for anyone traveling anywhere in the country are advisable.

Caution:

Make sure you follow standard hygiene measures, such as washing your hands frequently. Caution is also advised when eating raw fruit and salads. You should only drink tap water after it has been boiled, in at all. Taking a first-aid kit containing your regular medication plus medication for common travel-related illnesses is highly recommended.

Please note the changes in vaccination requirements for travelers via Johannesburg, South Africa on outbound and especially return flights (which came into force on 6/6/2011):

According to South African law, all travelers from the following countries MUST be vaccinated against yellow fever:

Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central Africa, Chad, Congo, Côte d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Kenya, Mali, Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Togo, Uganda, Tanzania, Zambia

We recommend: (This is not currently required by law, but you should consider it.) Given the current development mentioned above, we recommend yellow fever vaccinations if visiting the following countries in southern Africa: Mozambique, Zimbabwe, Botswana



INSURANCE

You are strongly advised to take out travel insurance for illness and ambulance services.







HUNTING IN THE RAINFOREST

PARTNER:

Hunting in the Rainforest with our partner MAYO OLD-IRI Safaris. All safaris are conducted on a 1:1 basis, each hunting guest is accompanied by a professional hunter with own hunting vehicle and a team of trackers and carriers. Per safari a maximum of two hunters stay in one camp at the same time.

The first and last day are travel days, thus booking our 16 Days Safari means you have 14 entire days hunting at your disposal. Depending on the flight connections, you might have the possibility to hunt on travel days as well.

Safaris in the camps Boumba North, Boumba South, Lognia, Lokomo, Dja and Covaref.

WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION:

In the vast majority of cases, the shooting distance will be between 15 and 20 meters, but often with relatively dense vegetation in the line of fire. We recommend a minimum caliber of .375 H&H or 9.3 mm or both versions of the .416 when hunting elephant. Bullet weight should have priority over velocity! A rifle scope is NOT required. A shotgun is essential for hunting duiker.

RAINFOREST:

- Charter flight from Douala to Kika/Lokomo. Cost for one-way flight: approx. USD 6,500.00 The plane carries 14 passengers without luggage and 10 with luggage.
- Two-day drive from Douala (Yaoundé is better) to the hunting area. Costs there and back: approx. USD 2,000.00

COMBINED SAFARIS (SAVANNA AND RAINFOREST):

- Charter flight from Tchollire to Kika. Cost is approx. USD 7,500.00
- Scheduled flight to Douala, overnight stay in Douala and then onward journey

WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION:

A combination of a medium and a large caliber is particularly advantageous (e.g., 7x64 and 9.3x64 or .270 Win. and .375 H&H MAG). If you are not hunting elephant, a medium caliber is advantageous, such as the 8x68S or .300 Mag.

LICENSES

The "Big Hunting License" allows harvesting of max. 2 game species from group A and 4 from group B and C. The "Special category license" allows for waterbuck, bushbuck and another four animals from B or C. The "Medium Hunting License" allows for 6 game species from groups B and C. It is not allowed to hunt two of the same species, irrespective of the license!

When booking the 15 Days Safari it is possible to purchase an additional "Medium License" at a surcharge of USD 2,500,— in order to hunt 6 further game species from groups B and C.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT



FOREST:

At least three complete dark green hunting outfits (long trousers, long sleeved shirts) and a light raincoat are recommended. Leather gloves, legging and glasses to protect you from vegetation and insects.

Two pairs of Gore Tex hunting boots and one pair of lights shoes for the camp.

Gore Tex socks are recommended.

SAVANNAH:

Some T-shirts, long trousers for hunting and shorts for staying at the camp, good boots and on the early season some light coat for the early morning.

Don't forget

Sunglasses, a hat/cap, a torch, camera and your lightweight pair of binoculars.
