OVERVIEW HUNTING AREAS







HUNTING IN THE RAINFOREST

PARTNER:

Hunting in the Rainforest with our partner MAYO OLD-IRI Safaris. All safaris are conducted on a 1:1 basis, each hunting guest is accompanied by a professional hunter with own hunting vehicle and a team of trackers and carriers. Per safari a maximum of two hunters stay in one camp at the same time.

Safaris in the camps Boumba North, Boumba South, Lognia, Lokomo, Dja and Covaref.

WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION:

In the vast majority of cases, the shooting distance will be between 15 and 20 meters, but often with relatively dense vegetation in the line of fire. We recommend a minimum caliber of .375 H&H or 9.3 mm or both versions of the .416 when hunting elephant. Bullet weight should have priority over velocity! A rifle scope is NOT required. A shotgun is essential for hunting duiker.

ARRIVAL RAINFOREST



A representative from our partner organization is always there to help you on arrival and departure from the following national airports: Douala, Yaoundé, Garoua, Ngaoundere, Bertoua, Moloundou and Kika.

On arrival in Cameroon, the following options are available for onward travel to the various hunting areas:

RAINFOREST:

- Charter flight from Douala to Kika/Lokomo. Cost for one-way flight: approx. EUR 5,000,—
- Two-day drive from Douala (Yaoundé is better) to the hunting area. Costs there and back: approx. EUR 3,500,—

DOCUMENTS:

Our partner requires the following documents at least one month before the start of the trip:

- Photocopy of your passport
- Photocopy of your entry visa (please ask and apply at your local Cameroon embassy)
- Photocopy of your weapons import permit (also via the Cameroon embassy)
- Medical certificate stating that your state of health is compliant with going hunting in Cameroon
- Six passport photos

The "Big Hunting License" allows harvesting of max. two game species from group A and four from group B and C.

The "Small Hunting License" allows for all game species from group C.

It is not allowed to hunt two of the same species, irrespective of the license!

Per safari a maximum of two hunters, stay in one camp at the same time.

WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION:

A combination of a medium and a large caliber is particularly advantageous (e.g., 7x64 and 9.3x64 or .270 Win. and .375 H&H MAG). If you are not hunting elephants, a medium caliber is advantageous, such as the 8x68S or .300 Mag.

ARRIVAL SAVANNAH



A representative from our partner organization is always there to help you on arrival and departure from the following national airports: Douala, Yaoundé, Garoua, Ngaoundere, Bertoua, Moloundou and Kika.

On arrival in Cameroon, the following options are available for onward travel to the various hunting areas:

SAVANNAH:

- Scheduled flight from Douala - Garoua - Douala, from where it is about a four-hour drive to the hunting area. Cost there and back: approx. EUR 350,-.

DOCUMENTS:

Our partner requires the following documents at least one month before the start of the trip:

- Photocopy of your passport
- Photocopy of your entry visa (please ask and apply at your local Cameroon embassy)
- Photocopy of your weapons import permit (also via the Cameroon embassy)

GAME SPECIES AND TROPHY FEES

LICENSES

The “Big Hunting License” allows harvesting of max. 2 game species from group A and 4 from group B and C

The “Special category license” allows for waterbuck, bushbuck and another four animals from B or C.

The “Medium Hunting License” allows for 6 game species from groups B and C. It is not allowed to hunt two of the same species, irrespective of the license!

When booking the 15 Days Safari it is possible to purchase an additional “Medium License” at a surcharge of USD 2,900,– in order to hunt 6 further game species from groups B and C.
