### CLIMATE

**Croatia:** In the interior, there is predominantly a temperate continental climate, but also a mountain climate in some areas. The coast has a Mediterranean climate. As a result of the dry Mediterranean Macchia, there is also a risk of forest fires during the summer months. Special care should therefore be taken at campsites that are not close to the beach.

**Serbia:** Continental climate



### HEALTH

**Croatia:** The quality of medical care in public hospitals away from larger cities and tourist centers does not always meet Austrian standards. There is an increased risk of tick bites especially in the forests of northern Croatia (risk of meningitis). The risk of rabies is about average for Europe and primarily affects animals.

**Serbia:** Hospitals and hygiene do not meet European standards in the south especially. There are cases of measles and West Nile virus."
