Recommended Equipment:

Footwear:

2 pairs of comfortable lightweight hiking boots or trekking shoes. "You need to be removed in advance and cozy". Since the temperature is hot and uneven cystics are often a problem and make the execution of hunting painful.

Boots should be an ankle support and breathability.

NOTE - high leather boots are not suitable for hot weather.

Clothes:

We recommend light khaki or green cotton clothing for the hot climate.

Short sleeve shirts and shorts

Some hunters prefer thin long sleeve shirts and long pants

Camouflage is a big advantage

Example 7-10 days list:

5x long / shorts / n

7x underwear, socks 7x

Pajamas

thin jacket

Sweater

big hat

2x pairs of boots for hunting / 1x pair of sneakers or sandals for the camp

Toiletries (razor), sewing kit
