



Hunt in Ireland:

Ireland is well-known as the "Green Island" with mild climate and rugged shores by most people. Wild yet romantic landscapes, old cottages and friendly people – the perfect island to relax your mind.

The Kerry region is one of the most beautiful in Ireland for hunting woodcock and snipe.





Woodcock & Snipe hunt

During one of our visits in early January we could hardly believe how many Woodcocks and Common Snipes inhabit the heathlands and woodlands. Hunts are conducted with Setters, Pointers and Springer Spaniels that retrieve the harvested Snipes. You can expect daily bags of 10 to 20 Snipes per hunter. Many French hunters have been traveling to Ireland for decades, when migrating Snipes come here. A classical, very appealing and exciting hunt, which demands good shooting skills. In higher regions during these hunts, you will also encounter the popular Red Grouse that are quite numerous in Ireland.

We offer with our partner J.M.M. Killorglin an unique opportunity for parties of 2 to 8 guns.

A hunting party is usually conducted as follows:

- Leave the accommodation at around 09.00 am with your guide
- Hunting until 1 pm
- Lunch in a local pub
- Hunting until sunset
- Possibility of a flight of ducks on certain terrain.





**Season:** Woodcock: from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 31<sup>st</sup> January

Snipe: from mid. October until late January



Journey:

The island is accessible from Germany by airplane – the arrival airport is Kerry Airport. Rental cars are available at the airports, but should be booked in advance, or you travel with your own car.

The firearm declaration for your own gun is organized by us in advance. At the latest 8 weeks prior to travel start date, the "European Firearms Pass", hunting license and the passport in original must be sent by mail to us. The actual Firearm Import Permit is then issued by the local authorities.

Weapons normally used: Shotgun 12, 16 and 20 - 28 calibers. There are rental rifles available on site.

Equipment

A well-known and applicable saying in Ireland is: "If you don't like the weather, just wait 10 minutes". For the choice of your equipment, you should definitely take this into consideration. Clothes should be durable, tear-proof, water-repellent and breathable. Furthermore you should bring sturdy and water-repellent shoes or high quality rubber boots. In the hunting areas, there are swampy, wet spots and slippery rocks.

Accommodation

Accommodation is arranged individually, fully depending on the client's taste. There are high quality hotels, but also simple "Bed and Breakfast" guesthouses or self-catering holiday homes for groups or families. The costs are payable on site or prior to the hunt via Blaser Safaris GmbH. We are happy to assist you in your choice of accommodation.


