- For leopard, cheetah and rhino must be requested CITES documents. For that we need at least 4 weeks prior to travel a color copy of your valid passport, and the current home address!
- Permits for leopard and cheetah are only valid during the booked hunting season of the Named guest Permits can't be moved / transferred on a different date and should be the course of a recent hunt in the same year, be renewed!
- Additional costs:
  - Cost for the permit Leopard EUR 550, and cheetah are EURO 350, -
  - These costs are not refundable, whether shot or not, and even in the wake of a renewed application are paid.










### DAS LAND
