



Hunting in Finland

Our partner Kartanon Riista offers hunting not far from Helsinki. You will be picked up at the airport and you will be transferred to Kytäjä, which is about 60 km away.





Airport: The nearest international airport is Helsinki, the nearest city is Hyvinkää (approx. 15 min.)

White-tailed deer: Hunt from the high-seat (morning and evening hunt): Hunting

method: October-February

Moose: Hunt from the high-seat (morning and evening hunt):

Mid September - end of December

Both game species can also be hunted in one area.

Other game: Roe deer, flying game (pheasant, partridge, waterfowl)

Weapon: Hire Rifle (SAKKO)

To obtain a Finnish hunting license and to enter Finland with a gun, please send us color copies of

the following documents

Name of the hunter, private address and country

Passport / Date of issue and expiry

Domestic hunting card / number and date of issue EU Firearms Pass (EU citizen) / Number and date of issue Hunting liability insurance for the hunting season

Brand and model, serial number and caliber of the gun to be taken for hunting and ammunition

Flight information arrival / departure

Climate: The climate in Helsinki, as in other parts of Finland, is considered cold temperate. The country is at

a transition between the continental and maritime climates. The weather is therefore largely determined by the westerly wind zone and its low pressure areas, which often leads to a rather humid climate and changeable weather. Between November and March it is extremely cold in Helsinki, even the average temperatures are often below freezing point. The summers are also rather moderate, even by German standards. In July and August you can expect maximum temperatures of around 21 to 22 degrees Celsius. Finland's weather is characterized by many rainy days throughout the year. In winter these make up about two thirds of the month, while during spring and summer they occur on about 15 to 16 days a month. There are enough hours of sunshine during the height of summer

- between May and August you can expect up to 6 to 8 hours per day.

Health: Vaccinations

Please inform yourself about the vaccination regulations of the respective country. You can obtain this information from the responsible tropical institute. If vaccinations are required, we would like to

point out that you yourself are responsible for complying with them.

Insurance: We recommend a travel insurance

Equipment list: 1 pair of good waterproof warm shoes (well broken in)

1 hunting jacket, preferably made of Gore-Tex

Hat and warm cap with ear protection 2 pairs of warm gloves (Gore-Tex)

1 pair of hut shoes or sneakers (for the camp)

light rainwear

2 pairs of durable warm long pants

warm socks, warm underwear, warm sweaters

comfortable shirts or T-shirts

Washing things

personal medication, own small first aid kit

Flashlight and spare batteries

Photo equipment, or film equipment, sufficient film (or digital camera) & batteries, etc.

light binoculars (8x30 or 10x40) for game viewing Backpack (light and silent for the daily game drives)

light seat cushion

Target stick (dismountable), if you are used to it

Duffel bags are better suited for transport than suitcases

Hunting rifle with scope and matching rifle case

Passport, European Firearms Pass (EFP) hunting and firearms license, driver's license, credit card,

traveller's cheques, airline tickets, etc
