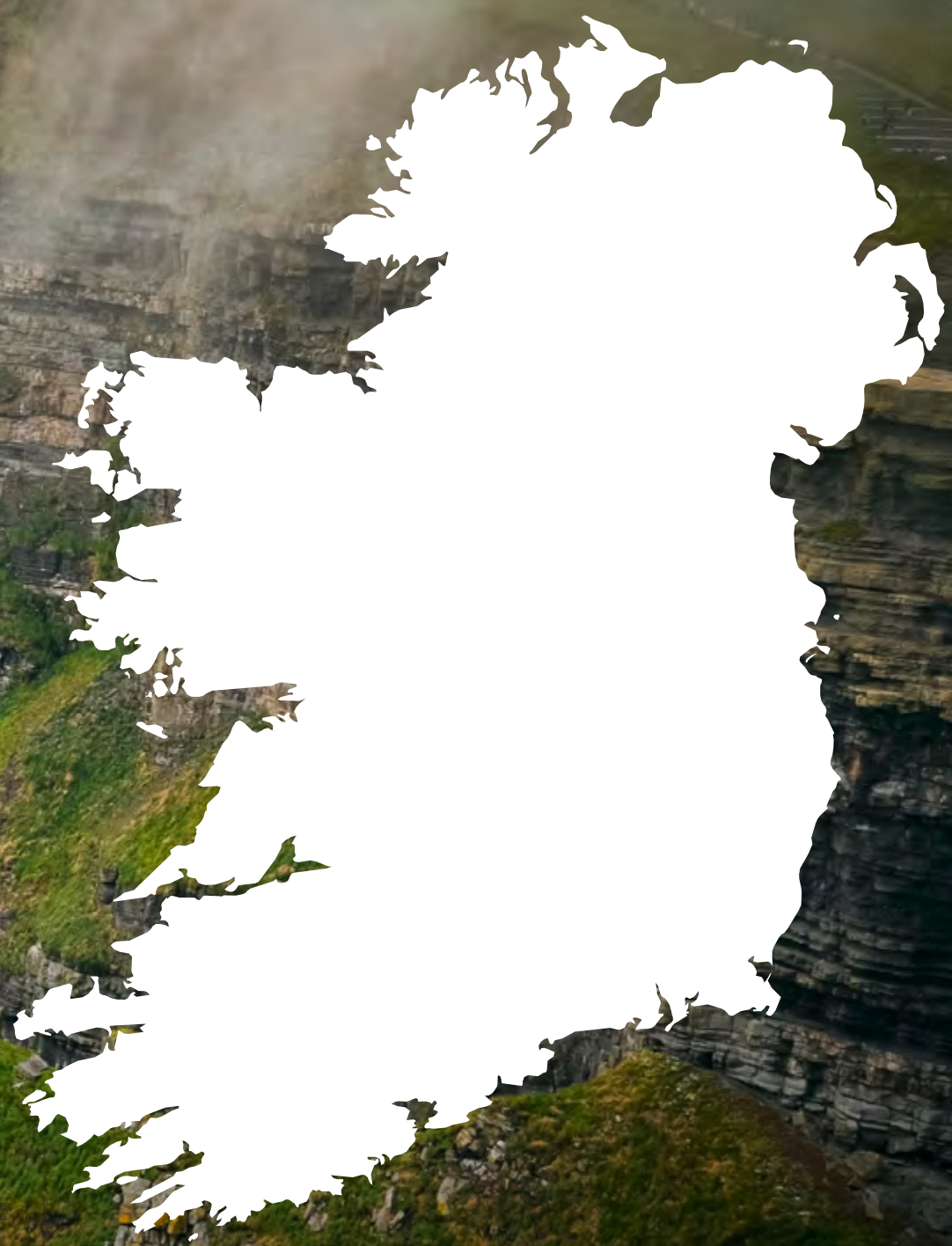

You should consider taking out travel insurance for illness and ambulance services.

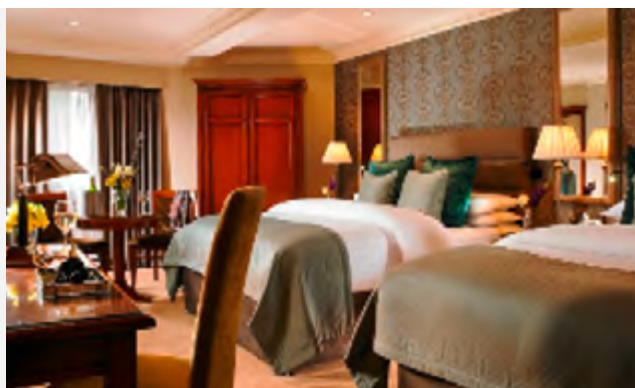


JOURNEY

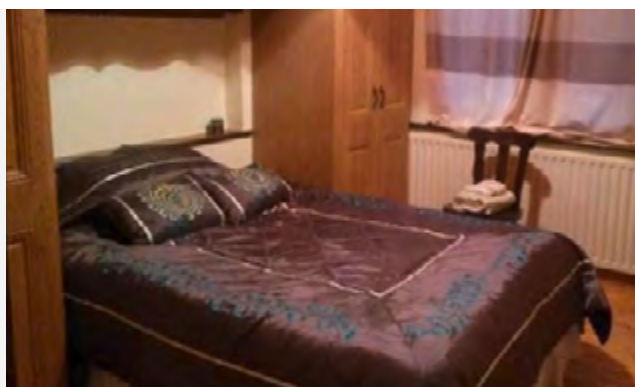

GENERAL HUNTING INFORMATION

During one of our visits in early January we could hardly believe how many woodcocks and common snipes inhabit the heathlands and woodlands. Hunts are conducted with setters, pointers and Springer Spaniels that retrieve the harvested snipes. You can expect daily bags of 10 to 20 snipes per hunter. Many French hunters have been traveling to Ireland for decades, when migrating snipes come here. A classical, very appealing and exciting hunt, which demands good shooting skills. In higher regions during these hunts, you will also encounter the popular red grouse that are quite numerous in Ireland.

PARTNER:

We offer with our partner J. M. M. Killoglin an unique opportunity for parties of 2 to 8 guns.



POSSIBLE ITINERARY:

- Leave the accommodation with your guide at around 9.00 am
- Hunting until 13.00 pm
- Lunch in a local pub
- Hunting until sunset
- Possibility of a flight of ducks on a certain terrain

FIREARM DECLARATION:

The firearm declaration for your own gun is organized by us in advance. At the latest 8 weeks prior to travel start date, the „European Firearms Pass“, hunting license and the passport in original must be sent by mail to us. The actual Firearm Import Permit is then issued by the local authorities.

WEAPONS:

Shotgun calibers 12, 16 and 20–28. Rental rifles available on site.

HUNTING SEASON:

Woodcock from 1st November to 31st January, snipe from mid October to end of January.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

A well-known and applicable saying in Ireland is „If you don't like the weather, just wait 10 minutes". For the choice of your equipment, you should definitely take this into consideration. Clothes should be durable, tear-proof, water-repellent and breathable. Furthermore you should bring sturdy and water-repellent shoes or high quality rubber boots. In the hunting areas, there are swampy, wet spots and slippery rocks.
