We welcome bow hunters for exciting and up-close adventures from specific bow hunting stands or spot and stalk in both general hunting areas and bow.hunting only areas as well.

You start with a coffee and light breakfast early to be in the stands before daylight breaks. Hunting continues until around 10 a.m. after which you'll return to your accommodations. During the day, relax, fish, swim and explore local tourism activities. A few hours prior to sunset, you'll embark on another thrilling hunting that extends until darkness falls.

## **HUNTING REGULATIONS:**


- Every hunting guest has to buy the national hunting card of the respective hunting area (against payment). This hunting card is provided by Blaser Safaris Ltd.
