This gives one the opportunity of taking all that South Africa has to offer the discerning hunter - from the tiny Cape Grysbok or Blue Duiker to Elephant and Buffalo, the list is endless. For non-hunters, there are a host of interesting photographic and touring options available. Accommodation varies from lodges, tented camps to chalets all with en-suite bathrooms within some of the most magnificent surroundings.

HUNTING SAFARIS

NORTHERN CAPE

KALAHARI ORYX

This rare South African gem stretches over 212 000 acres in the Northern Cape Province, making it the largest privately owned hunting concession in the country. The reserve forms part of the Kalahari Desert (meaning 'large thirst' in Tswana) which is a huge red sand basin that reaches from the Orange River up to Angola in the north, in the west to Namibia and in the east to Botswana.

The 5-star private lodge boasts four en-suite rooms overlooking the beautiful landscape. Four of the Big Five can be found roaming this landscape apart from other plains game such as Kudu, Springbuck, Oryx, Eland etc. one can also find Sable, Roan and Nyala. Being malaria free, having our own asphalt airstrip and being only 1,5 hour's flight from Johannesburg makes Kalahari Oryx one of the most exclusive hunting destinations in South Africa.





NYARA

Nyara is a stunning 30 000 acre hunting area, only a 30-minute drive from Kimberley. Nestled amid pristine South African savanna bushveld, speckled with camel-thorn and other trees, the setting is one of absolute beauty and seclusion. What was once an unknown, plain stretch of land in the Northern Cape valleys, is now an emerging piece of heaven on earth that simply has to be experienced. There are prolific numbers of trophy-quality plains-game species such as Roan, Sable, Gemsbuck, Eland, Tsessebe, Red Hartebeest, Blue Wildebeest, Lechwe, Giraffe, Springbuck and Impala, to name but a few. Nyara Lodge is in a class of its own, featuring a design that truly complements the environment, with mesmerizing views of the great outdoors.

LIMPOPO

RIVERDANCE LODGE NYATI RESERVE

Situated within the famous Waterberg biome, this 33,000 acre wilderness boasts the Big Five and five of the Dangerous Seven along with many different plains game species. Hunting is carefully managed and conducted in the spirit of fair chase with only mature, quality specimen harvested by means of walk and stalk. Blinds and hides provide bow hunters as well as rifle hunters with various opportunities, thereby catering to both disciplines. The closest port of entry is OR Tambo International (JNB), which is situated approximately 3 hours' drive from the reserve. The private runway also allows quick access to the area for clients' wishes to travel privately.

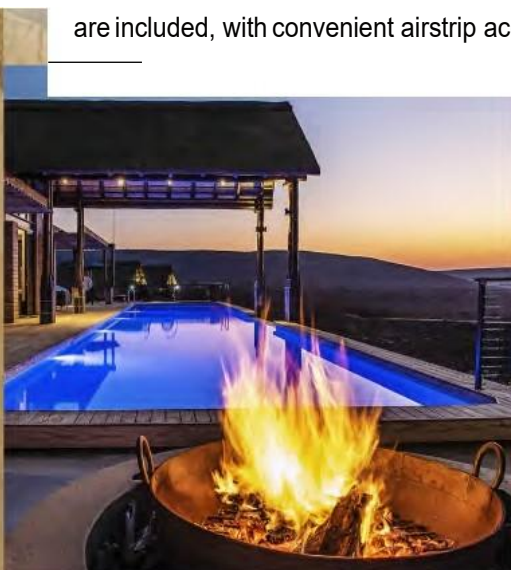

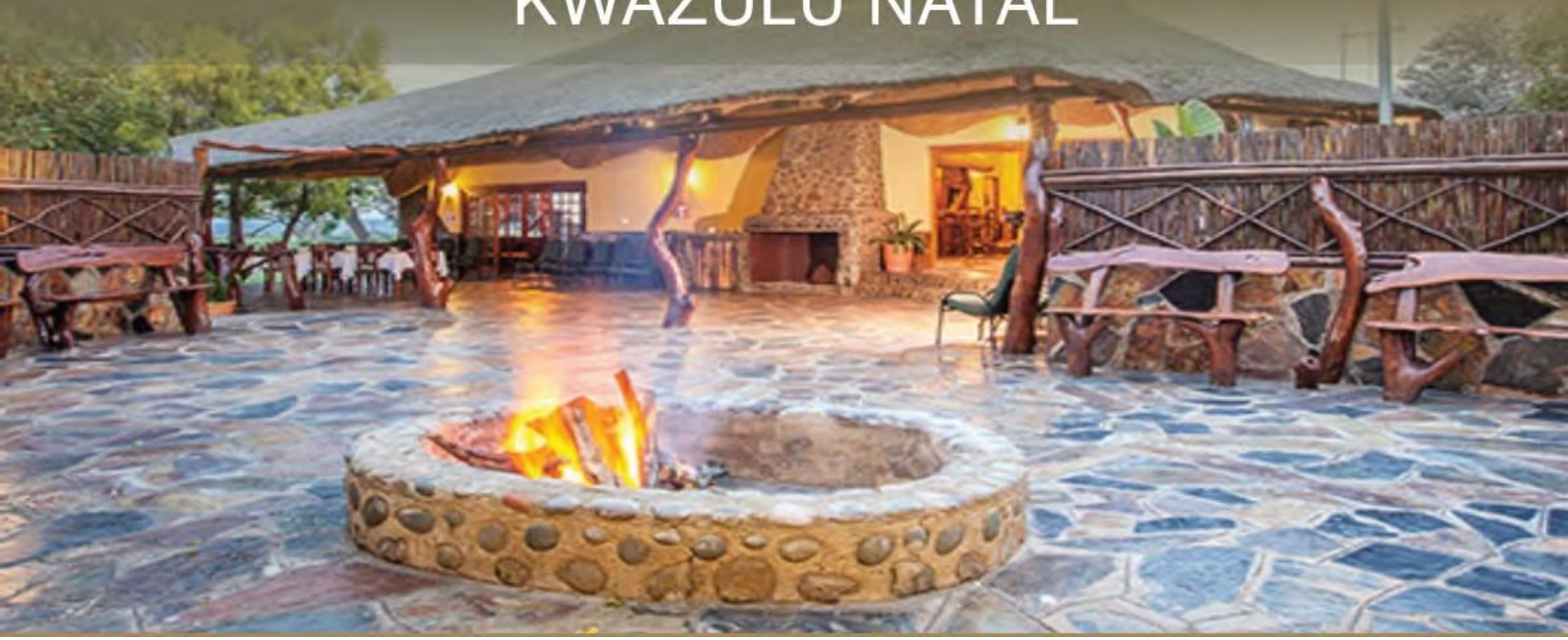

The Kalahari is renowned for exceptional Kudu, Gemsbuck, Eland, and Kalahari Springbuck. Bowhunting is best in the late season once the water starts to dry up. Hunting with Bushmen, who can read the tracks like a book, is an unforgettable experience. The Ghanzi District is situated in the Western corner of the central Kalahari, a 3-hour drive from Maun International Airport. The Kalahari is a semidesert and is reasonably flat with low scrub and grasses. Botswana was one of Africa's premier Elephant hunting destinations. In this area, we hunt a variety of private reserves. The area itself is roughly 120 000 acres in extent and is game-fenced. There are also outlying areas that are unfenced and hold great Kudu bulls. There is one main camp that we use, offering a combination of East African-styled tents and brick and tile chalets, all with en-suite bathrooms.

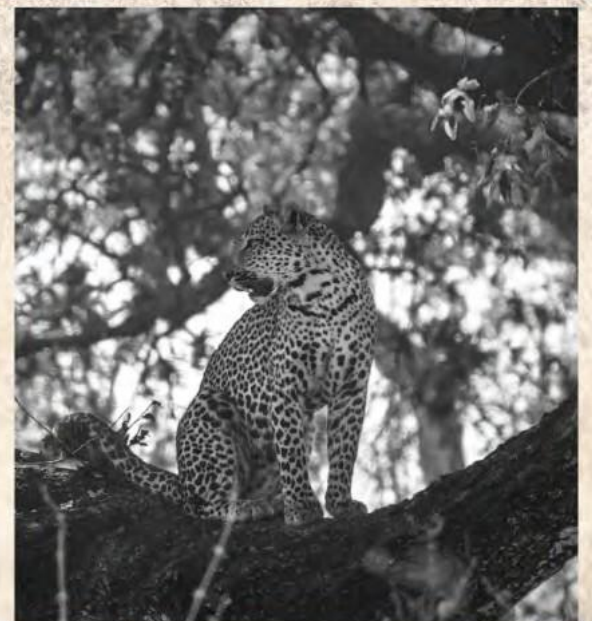

The hunt is conducted in hill country, where large cantankerous bulls live out their last days in isolation.
