# GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Please note the entry requirements for the respective country. Information can be obtained at the responsible consulate. In case a visa is needed, please be advised, that the acquisition is your own responsibility.

**For entering Sweden with a weapon, please send us the following document's colour photocopies:**

- Name of the hunter, adress and country
- Passport / date of issue and expiry date
- Hunting license / serial and issue date
- National Firearm license, EU firearm license (EU residents) / serial and issue date
- Valid international insurance for the period of the hunting trip
- Make and model, serial number and caliber of the firearm(s) that you intent to use in hunting and rounds
- Flight information arrival / departure



## CLIMATE

Cool continental climate due to its northern location, but generally feels quite moderate due to the influence of the Gulf Stream. The temperature drops as you head north. The summers are reasonably warm; winters are long and often snowy. Daylight is sparse in winter. The regions in the west and south receive the most rainfall. There is a dry, continental climate further inland.

### TIPS:

The temperature can drop suddenly in the north, so taking weatherproof and thermoregulating clothing with you is recommended. Spring in Sweden is very short. As a result of the long winter and short summer, everything begins to bloom at the same time from the middle to the end of May. This causes major difficulties for people who suffer with allergies.



## HEALTH

### Vaccination requirements

Please note the vaccination requirements for the respective country. Information can be obtained at the responsible tropical institute. In case a vaccination is needed, please be advised, that the adherence is your own responsibility.

### Caution

Taking a first-aid kit containing your regular medication plus medication for common travel-related illnesses is recommended. As there is a high risk of being infected with the TBEV virus in many forest areas in Sweden, having an appropriate preventative tick-borne encephalitis vaccination before travel is recommended.



## INSURANCE

We recommend a travel insurance.



# HUNTING AREA AND ACCOMMODATION



**AIRPORT:** The nearest international Airport to the camp is Vilhelmina/Lycksele. Alternatively Umea airport is also an option.

**METHOD OF HUNTING:** Black Grouse males are exclusively hunted on courtship territory, Hazel Grouse males are hunted with decoys and Capercaillie males are typically hunted for in the North Swedish region with the Finn Spitz.

**WEAPONS:** 22 Hornet or higher with full metal jacket. A shotgun over and under or a drilling is a very good choice.

**ACCOMMODATION:** Camp Lapponia – Hunts in the South of Lapland in 3 different areas

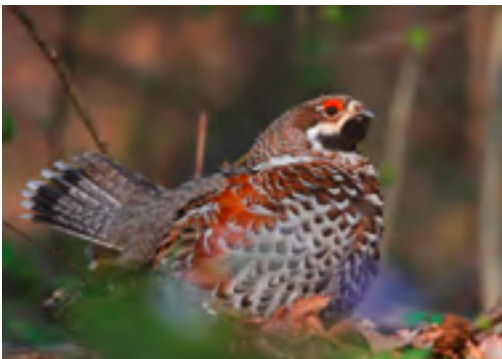

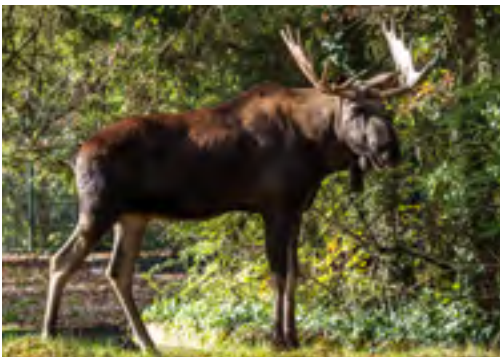
