Nyaminga GMA is situated in the world renowned Luangwa Valley, it lies across from the North Luangwa National Park on the Luangwa River which teems with hippo & enormous crocodile.

The area encompasses 200 square kilometres of Miombo woodland, savannah and rugged mountains. This varied habitat caters for the select variety of species found in Nyaminga GMA.

The hunting quota consists of Leopard, Buffalo, Chobe Bushbuck, Crocodile, Elephant, Grysbok, Hippo, Kudu, Oribi, Puku, Cookson's Wildebeest & a variety of other plains game.



Accommodation:

You will be accommodated in en-suite luxury safari tents on the banks of the Luangwa River. Served international cuisine and game meat provided by yourself, our well-trained friendly staff will cater to your every need where possible.

The nights are filled with the sounds of lions, leopards and hyenas, with the occasional elephant taking a stroll through camp.



- All prices are subject to change, should the Government alter any rates towards the safari company.
- Charter flights prices are subject to change due to fluctuating fuel prices.
- Balance of daily rate, trophy, charter flights or road transport and animal licenses are due 60 days prior to the contracted date.
- Cancellation: All deposits, less 10 % administration fee, will be refunded if safari is cancelled more than 6 months prior to commencement. Safaris cancelled less than 6 months prior to commencement, deposit will only be refunded if the safari can be re-booked in the same time slot.









Recommended Equipment:

The following list would generally be sufficient for a 10 day safari:

- 3-4 long sleeved shirts.
- 2 Pairs of trousers. Note: trousers with zip off legs work very well.
- 2 Pairs of shorts
- 3 T-Shirts or Shirts
- 3-4 Pairs of good quality cotton socks.
- 1 Jacket
- 1 thick fleece for the early mornings and evening.
- 1 Pair of comfortable soft soled walking shoes.
- Lightweight gloves
- Wide brimmed hat or baseball cap.

Basically, beige or green colored, tear-resistant clothing, preferably cotton, are recommended.

Most hunters are TRAVELING WITH CLOTHES THAT ARE TOO LIGHT IN COLOR FOR BUSHCLOTHES! Choose darker green or brown tones! In the camps, there is a laundry service, so not too much clothing needs to be taken.

Attention: Camouflage is forbidden in Zambia!

- Pens and an A4 folder for travel formalities
- Locks for your luggage
- Two seperate wallets
- Mobil phone and charger
- Mini sewina kit
- Lighter / waterproof matches
- Toiletries such as toothbrush, toothpaste, comb/ hair brushes, nail brush
- Moistering Cream, Lip balm
- Razor & blades, shaving gel
- Small vanity mirror
- Small wash cloth towels are supplied though in our camp
- Toilet paper and/or kleenex, wet wipes/hand sanitizer or no-water/antibacterial soap – very handy in the safari vehicle
- Suncream
- Personal medication
- First aid kit (Plasters, antiseptic ointment, painkillers, charcoal tablets etc) *
- Backpack
- Water bottle
- Flashlight, spare batteries
- Hunting knife
- Binoculars
- Sunglasses
- Spare glasses
- Small Photographic equipment (camera, film, batteries dust-proof plastic bag)
- Adapter
- GPS or Compass, if you want to use
- Weapon, variable riflescope (ideally 1,5-6fach), ammunition, cleaning utensils, rifle case (Do not scrimp on ammunition, on site is the ammunition purchase is not possible!)

Passport, driving license, EFP (European firearms pass). Credit card, traveler's checks, airline ticket.



If you are planning a hotel stay before or after the hunt, a jacket and tie should also be packed in your luggage!

*Your kit should include:

- Sunscreens
- Eye, Ear and Nose drops
- Thermometer (digital)
- Scissors and forceps
- Field dressings and plasters
- Disinfectants
- Wound and healing balm
- Insect repellent
- The usual long-term medication

And the following medicines:

- Against fever, diarrhea and vomiting
- Stomach discomfort
- Sickness
- Sunburn
- Insect bites
- Circulatory problems
- Insomnia
- For pain relief (always carry them with you! its no use if you have an accident in the field and they're in the camp!)
- Constipation
- Against sore throat

Health Precaution:

Zambia is a Malaria area and clients must take precautions. It is suggested that you take "Larium" or "Malarone" tablets – with your doctor's approval.

Entry requirements

Vaccination requirements:
